Varsity/Freshman -Tier One

It be a 6 week program running from Monday June 27th through Friday August 5th and includes the Philly Youth Regatta. The high school Tier One option summer fee will be \$495.

If you are choosing this option, the first installment of \$250 is due on June 10th, the last day of spring practice. The remaining balance of \$245 is due July 10th.

Varsity/Freshman - Tier Two
